In addition, we have 'Produce of' and 'Made in' versions of the logos in the above colours and formats.





Global UNESCO logo








- Images should be saved in Photoshop as 'Export>Save for Web>JPEG HIGH or PNG-24. If this is not possible we can scale the images on your behalf.








The image that sits behind the video play button: 1600 X 900 Pixels






